

**VILLAGE OF TREMPEALEAU
SPECIAL PARKS AND RECREATION
COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
JUNE 1, 2010**

1. Roll Call and Call to Order

Chairperson Lois Taylor called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. Present: Kurt Wood and Cindy Wegner. Others: Administrator Travis Cooke, Clerk/Treasurer Vicki Freeman, Chad Grabau, Pool Manager, and John Ebersold, Streets Superintendent.

2. Approval of the May 3, 2010 Minutes

Kurt Wood made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Cindy Wegner with the addition to the minutes that Cindy Wegner was absent at the May 3rd meeting. Motion carried.

3. Consideration/Discussion of TYSC Pool Use and Village Relations

Nancy Brown, Karen Sepich, and Canda Olson appeared on behalf of the Trempealeau Youth Sports Club to discuss arrangements for morning practices for the swim team. The morning sessions had been eliminated due to low usage in the past and to allow for time to vacuum the pool before swim lessons start. TYSC was concerned that the changes had been made after parents had been given schedules and made arrangements to get the swimmers to practice. It was also noted that last year was an unusually cool summer which contributed to the low morning usage. There was a lengthy discussion on the condition of the pool, finding time to vacuum the pool, and who is qualified to clean the pool.

Kurt Wood proposed allowing swim team practice on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 7:15 to 8:45 a.m. in addition to previously scheduled times. Training will be provided to four of the coaches so they can vacuum on Wednesdays and Chad will handle the vacuuming on Monday and Friday. TYSC will document how many swimmers are using the pool in the morning and adjustments will be made, if needed.

Chad also reported that the pool hours until school is out for the summer will be weekdays from 3 - 8 p.m. and weekends from 1 - 9 p.m.
