1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Chair Tom Scherr called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM. Present: Tom Scherr, Cindy Wegner, and Kurt Wood. Others Present: Travis Cooke, Village Administrator, John Ebersold, Streets Superintendent, Nancy Brown, TYSC President, Corey Feyen and Terry Thompson, Galesville Republican.

2. Approval of the August 3, 2009 Minutes

Motion by Wegner to approve the August 3, 2009 minutes. Seconded by Scherr. Motion carried 3-0.

3. Consideration of Pool Manager Hire

Motion by Wegner to approve hiring Chad Grabau as pool manager for the 2010 season at \$15 per hour to the Village Board. Seconded by Wood. Motion carried 3-0.

4. TYSC Update – Nancy Brown

Nancy Brown was present to report on the activities of TYSC for the coming year. They will be doing field work and have completed improvements to the facility roofs. TYSC now meets year round and has formulated written policies and procedures. Rookie ball will be offered this summer as a transition from t-ball to pitch ball. New fund raisers will be tried this year in lieu of fun-night. Kurt asked about long range planning and a general discussion was held.

5. Reciprocal Arrangement Between TYSC and Galesville Rec Program

Nancy discussed the issue with Galesville participants coming into TYSC and Trempealeau municipality residents attending Galesville's program and how this affected the final count for billing purposes. Going forward there will not be reciprocal billing between TYSC and Galesville. Participants who wish to join TYSC and live outside their taxing jurisdictions will pay the full participation fee to TYSC and that member will not be part of the count that is used to bill each TYSC municipality.

6. Updates and Other Discussion with no Action

Cindy would like to see a reduced rate single pass for youth at the pool. The next meeting will be at a special time to accommodate Chad's schedule.
