

**VILLAGE OF TREMPEALEAU
STREETS AND ALLEYS COMMITTEE MINUTES

APRIL 20, 2010**

1. Roll Call and Call to Order

Chair Koelbl called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Present: Joan Koelbl, Tom Scherr, and Kurt Wood. Others present: Travis Cooke, Village Administrator and Phil Palzkill.

2. Approval of the March 15, 2010 Minutes

Motion by Scherr to approve the March 15, 2010 Minutes. Seconded by Wood. Motion carried 3-0.

3. Old Business

A. Lutheran Church Drainage

The Committee reviewed a proposal from Winona Mechanical to install a 12" storm sewer and catch basin to run from the low area near the Lutheran Church to the manhole beneath Pine Street. The Committee came to the consensus to add this project to the 2010 street improvement plan.

4. New Business

A. 2010 Paving Planning

The Committee reviewed cost estimates for 2010 paving and came to the consensus to advertise for bids for asphalt work on Jay Street from 6th to 10th and 300' of Lake Rd. near Hungry Point.

5. Street Superintendent's and/or Administrator's Report

Cooke updated the Committee on new estimates for the salt shed planned for 2011.

6. Any Other Business Which Lawfully Comes Before the Committee (No Action)

Phil Palzkill was present to discuss the alley along his property and the proposed new gas station. He was interested in the possibility of closing the alley. The Committee informed him that the process is costly and would need to be initiated by the property owners who would want it closed. Phil discussed a privacy fence to be constructed by the gas station owners at a height of 8'. 8' height is permitted when an abutting property is in a more restrictive zone.

7. Adjournment

Motion by Scherr to adjourn the meeting at 5:44 PM. Seconded by Wood. Motion carried 3-0.
