STREETS AND ALLEYS COMMITTEE MINUTES

MARCH 15, 2010**

1. Roll Call and Call to Order

Chair Koelbl called the meeting to order at 6:05 PM. Present: Joan Koelbl, Tom Scherr, and Kurt Wood. Others: Travis Cooke, Village Administrator, John Ebersold, Streets Superintendent, Joel VonHaden and Terry Thompson, Galesville Republican.

2. Approval of the February 8, 2010 Minutes

Motion by Scherr to approve the February 8, 2010 Minutes. Seconded by Koelbl. Motion carried 3-0.

3. Old Business

A. Curb and Gutter Assessments – First St.

The Committee came to the consensus of \$8.50 per foot for the First St. curb and gutter assessments.

B. Lutheran Church Drainage

John is working with Winona Mechanical on a solution and will report back when the information comes in.

C. Salt Shed Planning

The Committee came to the consensus to budget for a 40' x 100' salt shed with concrete walls, a hoop roof and asphalt floor on the capital budget for 2011.

4. New Business

A. Stop Signs at 7th and King

Motion by Scherr to replace the yield signs on 7th St. at King with stop signs to improve safety. Seconded by Koelbl. Motion carried 3-0.

B. Drainage on Lake Rd – Joel VonHaden

Joel was present to address drainage and ponding issues on Lake Rd. near Hungry Point. John proposed milling 150-200 feet of street and laying asphalt to improve drainage. The county will be in shortly to help estimate street improvements for 2010 and will look at the project to be considered at the street construction planning meeting.

C. Chamber Sponsored Bike Paths – Joel VonHaden

Motion by Wood to permit the Chamber to paint stencils on Village streets indicating various bike routes through and around the Village. Seconded by Scherr. Motion carried 3-0.

5. Street Superintendent's and/or Administrator's Report

A. Other Informational Updates

John has started sweeping the streets. A brief discussion was held on vehicle replacement and curb breakouts at the Duck Pond.
