SECTION II. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, or other applicable administrative or governing body, such decision shall not effect the validity of any other section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph or portion thereof. The Village of Trempealeau Board of Trustees hereby declares that they would have passed this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, paragraph or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more other sections, subsections, sentences, clauses, paragraphs, or phrases may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION III. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES REPEALED. All ordinances in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed or amended to read consistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. ADOPTION. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
